County & Borough Council  Weight Restriction Signs Cartford Bridge – the Local Government Act 1972 details a wide range of powers and functions which the Parish Council can undertake including the power to provide traffic signs under the statutory provision of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 S72. This would require the permission of the highway authority. It was resolved that the clerk will request permission for from the highway authority for the Parish Council to provide 7.5 ton weight restriction signs on the A586 approaches to Little Eccleston. The current signs on the corner of Blackpool Old Rd & Cartford Lane are often not noticed resulting in HGVs attempting to turn or reverse and turn in Cartford Lane as they are over the limit. The Parish Council requested signs from the Highways authority in July but there is no determined time scale for this to be carried out.
